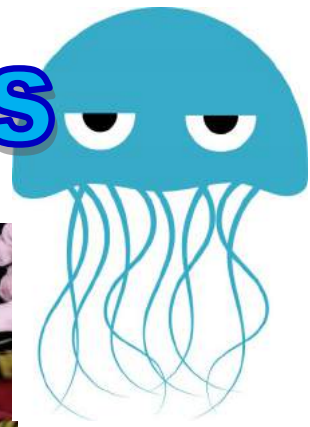
Board meeting next Wednesday 22 June 1.45pm All welcome to come and meet our new and existing members.

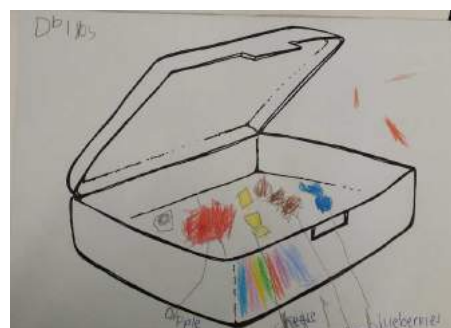
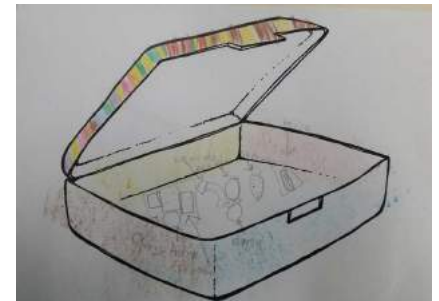
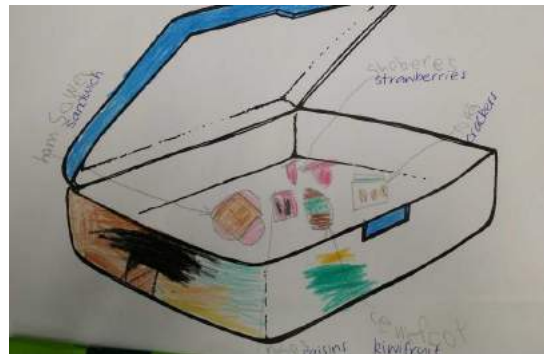


Deep Sea Divers
